Activity Fees	INCLUDED (\$600)	High school sports participation fees and field trip transportation costs during the school year. <i>Does not include food, lunch, or entrance fees.</i>

General Policy NCA is a non-profit school ministry, and we strive to make our high-quality education program affordable to as many families as possible. Tuition and fees are, thus, set each year at the level that allows the school to fulfill its mission successfully. Each year, generous donations cover costs that tuition and fees do not.

Additional Items

Lunch Hot lunches (including condiments and utensils) are catered to school each day. A monthly menu is provided to families in advance, and lunch orders can be placed at www.boonli.com. The cost per serving is around \$11 at the time of this publication. Students are, of course, welcome to bring their own sack lunch.

Uniform NCA students are required to wear school uniforms. Various uniforms for school days and PE can be purchased at a designated uniform store (<https://skobels.com/collections/new-covenant-academy>).

Other Fees Parents are responsible for other costs related to any special events or activities outside of school that NCA participates in (i.e. Math Olympics, Spelling Bee, etc.). NCA only requires the actual cost of participation.

Refund Policy All tuition and fees are non-refundable. Tuition will not be prorated and/or refunded. When requesting a transfer or withdrawal, all outstanding tuition and fees must be paid in full in order to release student records.

Admission Deadlines for New Students/Families

Regular Admissions

- Application Deadline: January 20
- Notification of Admissions Decision: January 30
- Registration Fee Due: \$2600 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance (\$200 reduction)

Rolling Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: \$2800 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance

Mid-Year Transfers/Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: prorated from \$2800

Re-Enrollment for Current Students

All current students are automatically re-enrolled or re-registered for the upcoming school year UNLESS otherwise indicated.

Regular Re-Enrollment

If completed by January 20: \$2600

Completed after January 20: \$2800

Kindergarten Applications

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential pre-school recommendation form(s)

Kindergarten applicants are typically assessed for developmental readiness as part of the admissions process. Our Admissions Director will schedule your child's assessment date, time and method.

Grades 1-5 Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

Grades 6 and Above Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Confidential counselor or administrator recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

Scholarships

NCA provides generous scholarships to PKs (children of full-time pastors) or MKs (children of full-time missionaries or such missionaries on sabbatical) who have proven track records and potential for advancement. PKs and MKs will need to provide documents such as a certificate of commissioning, the commissioning organization's verification letter, ministry records, ordination certificate, etc. Please inquire for more information.
