If not available, NCA will administer Terra Nova or Stanford 10 assessments. There is a testing fee of \$100. An interview is also required. 			
Middle and High School Applicants			
 Copy of child's official birth certificate Confidential teacher recommendation forms Confidential counselor or admin rec. forms Copy of transcript or at least previous 3 years grades Standardized test scores may be required. NCA will also administer Terra Nova or Stanford 10 or SAT/ACT assessments. There is a testing fee of \$100, and it may take 3 to 4 hours for full assessment. An interview is also required.

If you are applying for financial aid, you will need to submit the most recent 3 years of W-2's or tax returns. We cannot process your financial aid application until all required documents and applications have been submitted. Please inquire within for more information.

<u>Lunch</u>
