#### **Additional Items**

**Lunch** Hot lunches (including condiments and utensils) are catered to school each day. A monthly menu is provided to families in advance, and lunch orders can be placed at <u>www.boonli.com</u>. The cost per serving is roughly \$10 at the time of this publication. Students are, of course, welcomed to bring their own sack lunch or use the microwave oven to heat-up their food.

**Uniform** NCA students are required to wear school uniforms. Various uniforms for school days and PE can be purchased at Dennis Uniforms (<u>www.dennisuniform.com</u>) or at their Los Angeles store.

**Other Fees** Parents are responsible for other costs related to sports participation or any special events outside of school (i.e, Math Olympics, Spelling Bee, etc.). NCA only requests actual costs of participation.

**Donations** In addition to NCA's family contribution mentioned above, parents are asked to participate in the Annual Capital Campaign to support NCA. All funds raised will be used to enrich the student learning experience at NCA. Donations are tax-deductible.

**Refund Policy** All tuition and fees are nonrefundable. Tuition will not be prorated and/or refunded. When requesting transfer/withdrawal, all outstanding tuition and fees must be paid in full in order to release student records.

# **Admission Deadlines for New Students/Families**

## **Regular Admissions**

- Application Deadline: January 31
- Notification of Admissions Decision: February 10
- Registration Fee Due: \$2500 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance

#### **Rolling Admissions**

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: \$2500 within 5 days of receiving admissions acceptance

### Mid-Year Transfers/Admissions

- Application accepted if space is available
- Notification of Admissions Decision: within 10 days of application submission
- Registration Fee Due: prorated from \$2500

# **Re-Enrollment for Current International Students**

All current students are automatically re-enrolled or re-registered for the upcoming school year UNLESS otherwise indicated.

### **Kindergarten Applications**

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential pre-school recommendation form(s)

Kindergarten applicants are typically assessed for developmental readiness as part of the admissions process. Our Admissions Director will schedule your child's assessment date/time and method.

### Grades 1-5 Applicants

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

### **Grades 6 and Above Applicants**

- Copy of child's official birth certificate
- Confidential teacher recommendation forms
- Confidential counselor or administrator recommendation forms
- Copy of transcript or up to previous 3 years' grades and/or report cards

Standardized test scores may be required. If not available, NCA will administer its own assessments. The testing fee is included in the application fee. An interview is required.

# Scholarships

NCA provides generous scholarships to PKs (children of full-time pastors) or MKs (children of full-time missionaries or such missionaries on sabbatical) who have proven track record and potential for advancement.
